Search for things to fix!

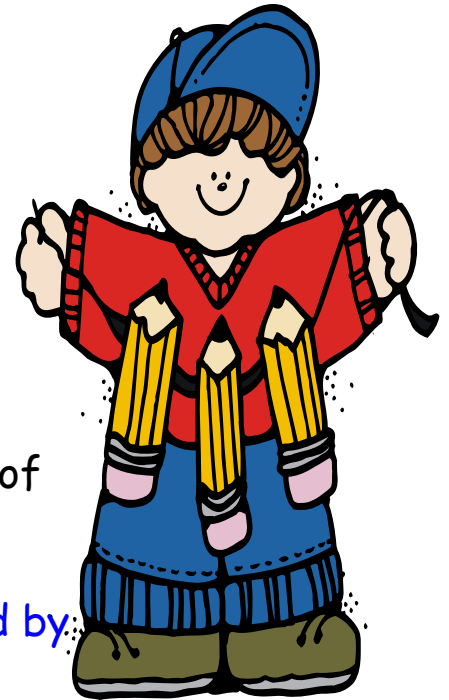
A.R.R.R.

Rearranging- Is the information in the most logical and most effective order?

Removing- What extra details or unnecessary bits of information can I delete or remove?

Replacing- What words or details could be replaced by a clearer or stronger expression?

- ❖ Single sided
- ❖ Single spaced
